

CHECKING FIREFOX

Checking your version of Firefox is as simple as these easy steps. Follow the following instructions, and you should be able to check your Firefox version.



Click the menu button  , click **Help** and select **About Firefox** . The About Firefox window will appear. The version number is listed underneath the Firefox name.

Here is an example of what the About Firefox window will look like:



Opening the About Firefox window will, by default, start an update check. If an updated version of Firefox is available, it will be automatically downloaded.

Firefox updates happen automatically when you access the About Firefox page if it's not current. You can always check for updates at any time, in which case an update is downloaded but not installed until you restart Firefox.

1. Click the menu button  , click  Help and select **About Firefox** .
2. The **About Mozilla Firefox** window opens. Firefox will check for updates and download them automatically.



3. When the download is complete, click **Restart to update Firefox** .



Once it's done, Congratulations! You're now running the latest version of Firefox!

Firefox should check for updates and install them automatically, but sometimes the process fails or is delayed, so this will give you peace of mind that you have the latest version.

Running the latest version of your web browser is an important step in being safe and secure online.
